The Lumberjacks went 1-1 last week with a win over the Eagles and a loss to the Vikings ... Montana and Montana State both travel to Sacramento, Calif. to take on the Hornets, who went undefeated last week against the Bengals and the Wildcats. Sacramento State beat Idaho State before edging out Weber State 3-2 on Saturday. Now the Hornets are 2-2 in Big Sky play ... Montana and Montana State matched up in a rivarly contest on Friday. The Grizzlies picked up their fifth-straight victory over the Bobcats ... Eastern Washington returns home to take on Portland State in Cheney, Wash. ... In non-conference action, Northern Colorado plays No. 13 nationally-ranked Colorado State on Tuesday evening, while Sacramento State takes on the Wolfpack at Nevada.

BIG SKY TV

After two years as a pay service, fans around the globe will be able to enjoy action from the Big Sky Conference for free.

The league's video streaming web service will bring fans 49 football games in 2008, including every single conference tilt. Action begins on Thursday, Aug. 28 when Weber State plays host to Montana-Western.

The Big Sky Conference will once again partner with Broadcast International of Salt Lake City to bring fans all football, volleyball and men's and women's basketball games held in league venues. All told, more than 400 events will be video streamed in 2008-09.

On top of moving to a free service, the league member institutions, the conference office and Broadcast International have been working to make viewing easier and better.

All institutions will be required to provide Broadcast International two-camera shoots from the events. Watching archived games will be easier, as will watching live action.

Over the past two seasons, Big Sky TV has produced nearly 1,000 events, making it the most comprehensive video streaming site of any athletic conference.

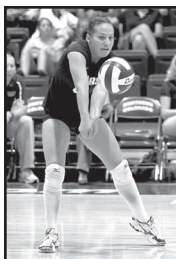

NORTHERN COLORADO'S VANDERMOST TABBED BIG SKY PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Northern Colorado's Breanna Vandermost was tabbed the Big Sky Volleyball Player of the Week for matches played between Sept. 29-Oct. 6.

Vandermost helped lead the Bears last week as they knocked off the top two teams in the conference standings. Northern Colorado swept Eastern Washington on Thursday and upended Portland State 3-1 on Saturday at home to move into second place in the Big Sky.

The junior libero tallied 36 digs on the week for a 5.14 average. She spearheaded a defense that held Eastern Washington's Hayley Hills and Portland State's Lindsey Steele to eight kills apiece. Vandermost notched 25 digs against the Vikings, which was the second highest single-match total of her career. She also added three assists and knocked down two kills on three attempts for a .667 hitting percentage.

Vandermost, a native of Colorado Springs, Colo., ranks third in the conference in digs per set this season with 4.50.

LAST WEEK'S TOP PERFORMERS

Jalen Pendon-Thomas, Portland State - The senior libero helped Portland State to a split on the road last week, averaging 6.75 digs per set and setting a school record in the process. Pendon-Thomas tallied 33 digs in the Vikings 3-1 win at Northern Arizona on Thursday night, setting a record for digs in a four-set match. That gave her a remarkable 8.25 digs per set average for the match, and she also added two service aces. On Saturday at Northern Colorado, Pendon-Thomas dug a team-high 21 balls, giving her 54 total digs for the weekend.

Maddison Thivierge, Sacramento State - Thivierge helped lead Sacramento State to victories over Idaho State and Weber State last week after combining for 2.75 kills and 1.00 blocks per game to go along with a team-best .404 hitting percentage. She had 22 kills, including a career-best 15 against Weber State. In the Hornets' five set thriller against the Wildcats on Saturday night, Thivierge led all players with a .467 hitting percentage, while also adding two aces, four digs and five blocks. In Friday's win over Idaho State, she notched seven kills, three blocks and a .294 hitting percentage.

Lexi Sullivan, Northern Arizona - Sullivan, a freshman outside hitter, recorded 4.25 kills per set as Northern Arizona split matches at home for the week, losing 3-1 to league-leading Portland State but rebounding for a 3-1 win over Eastern Washington. Sullivan recorded a match-high 18 kills against the Vikings, also tallying six digs and a service ace. Against Eastern Washington, Sullivan knocked down a team-high 16 kills and recorded three digs. For the weekend, Sullivan hit .226 and averaged 1.12 digs per set. She leads the team for the season with 3.87 kills per set.

Brittney Bisailon, Weber State - Bisailon averaged 2.77 kills, hit .358, and had 1.54 blocks per set in Weber State's three matches last week. She had seven kills and four blocks in a 3-1 loss to Utah, then posted 15 kills and eight blocks, while hitting .464 in WSU's 3-1 win over Cal State Bakersfield on Thursday. She followed that up with 14 kills and eight blocks in a 3-2 loss at Sacramento State.

Taryn Wright, Montana - Wright had 30 assists, three blocks and two service aces to lead Montana to a 3-0 victory over Montana State in the Grizzlies' lone match of the week. She added three kills on .400 hitting, and four digs. Wright led Montana to .205 hitting as the Grizzlies won their fifth-straight match over the Bobcats.

Hayley Hills, Eastern Washington - Hills had 26 kills against Northern Arizona, tied for the second-highest total by a Big Sky player this year and finished the week with 4.86 kills per set (34 total) and 2.43 digs per set (17 total). She also contributed four blocks and two service aces.

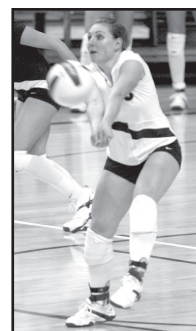
